# Big Ben

Big Ben - common name of the Elizabeth Tower clock tower in

London, UK.

The name originally referred to the bell from St. Stephen's Tower, also known as The Clock Tower, belonging to the Palace of Westminster. Today, the name Big Ben often refers to both the bell and the clock and the tower itself.



# Buckingham Palace

Buckingham - the official London residence of British monarchs.  
The world's largest royal palace.

One of the late baroque  
architecture.



# Tower Bridge

Tower Bridge - a drawbridge in London that crosses the Thames near the Tower of London. It is a drawbridge, allowing the passage of ocean-going vessels up to about 40.5 m above the water level. Tower Bridge It was compared with the famous Eiffel Tower, built five years earlier.



# London eye

The London Eye is an observation wheel located in the Lambeth district of London, on the south bank of the River Thames, between the Westminster and Hungerford Bridges



The British telephone booth was the first public telephone in the world. It was invented in 1884.

Initially, they were called "the public call office."



In public transport, mainly in Great Britain, where the London Routemaster is the most recognizable model.
