MUSEUMS IN LONDON



THE SCIENCE MUSEUM



Is a major museum on Exhibition Road in South Kensington, London. It was founded in 1857 and to date is one of the city's major tourist attractions, attracting 3.3 million visitors annually.

VICTORIA AND ALBERT MUSEUM



In London is the world's largest museum of applied and decorative arts and design, as well as sculpture, housing a permanent collection of over 2.27 million objects.

DESIGN MUSEUM



Small museum located on the Thames near Tower Bridge in the very center of the British capital. The museum presents exhibits related to the broadly understood design – architectural, industrial, utility, related to fashion, as well as graphics.

NATIONAL MARITIME MUSEUM (NMM)



Is a maritime museum in Greenwich, London. It is part of Royal Museums Greenwich, a network of museums in the Maritime Greenwich World Heritage Site.

THE BRITISH MUSEUM



A national museum based in London, the largest museum in Great Britain and one of the largest in the world – has about 8 million exhibits, with a particularly rich archaeological and ethnographic collection.
