The activity started in Scandinavia at the end of the 19th century as a training exercise for military officers, but it quickly became popular among ordinary people. The first competition open to the public was held in Norway in 1897.

Taking part in an orienteering game requires good navigational skills as the competitors need to use a compass and a map to locate all the necessary points on their route. They also need to be really fit to run fast over difficult terrain.

Nowadays orienteering is a nonular sport in many countries, with plenty of different types of international
