

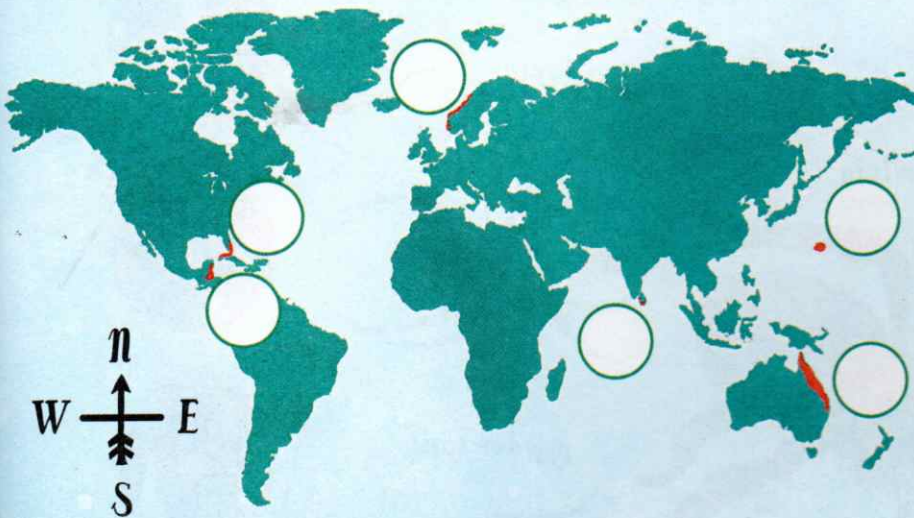
Coral reefs

Clues

The Bar Reef is further south than the Minami-Tori-shima Reef.

The Great Barrier Reef is furthest south.

The Belize Barrier Reef is further west than the Sula reef.

The Florida Barrier Reef is north of the Belize Barrier Reef and west of the Sula Reef.

The Sula Reef is further north than the others.
