





Sea forecast





The weather at sea can change quickly. Anyone planning a sailing trip should check the weather forecast very carefully before setting off.

Study the weather forecast for the island for three different days below. Which day would be the best to visit?





6th May

-  7am Showers, light winds, warm
-  10am Sunny intervals, breezy, warm
-  1pm Drizzle, strong winds, cool
-  4pm Heavy rain, strong winds, cool

11th May

-  7am Sunny, light winds, warm
-  10am Drizzle, light winds, warm
-  1pm Rain showers, light winds, warm
-  4pm Rain showers, light winds, cool

15th May

-  7am Sunny, light winds, warm
-  10am Thundery showers, strong winds, cool
-  1pm Rain showers, strong winds, cool
-  4pm Heavy rain, breezy, cool
